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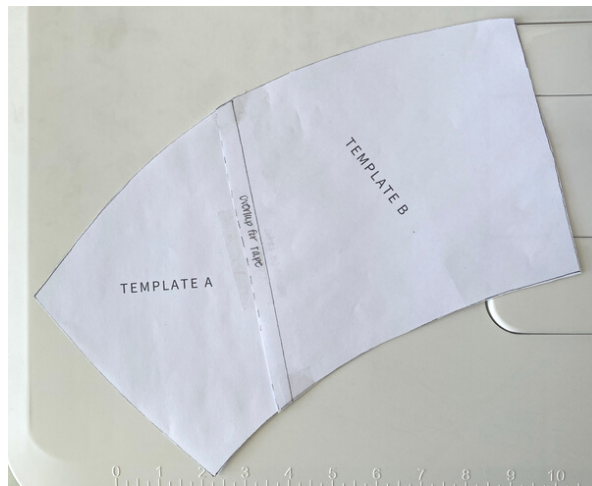
COFFEE COZY PATTERN | IT'S ONLY FABRIC AND THREAD

Before you begin:

- Pattern assumes basic sewing knowledge.
- Pattern is for personal use only. Do not copy, sell or distribute without written consent.
- License to sell: You may sell items made using this pattern as a small independent seller. Please credit the pattern design to "It's Only Fabric and Thread".

Fabric Requirements:

- (2) pieces of cotton fabric that measure at least 14" x 9"
- Insulated batting (you can substitute regular batting, however, I recommend doubling up and doing two layers if possible)
- Template provided on page 5 & 6
 - After cutting out the templates, template A and B should be taped on the solid line, resulting in one continuous piece as shown below.



Cutting Requirements:

1. Use the template to cut the shape from the first fabric.



2. Use the template to cut the shape from the first fabric.



Cutting Requirements (continued):

3. Use the template to cut the shape from the insulated batting.



Assembling the Coffee Cozy:

1. Lay out the insulated batting. Add the matching fabric piece on top, right side up. Lay the second fabric on top, right side down and pin/clip in place.

2. Stitch around using a scant 1/4" seam from the edge, leaving 3 - 3 1/2" opening on the right side.

3. Stitch around using a scant 1/4" seam from the edge, leaving 3 - 3 1/2" opening on the right side.



4. Clip the corners. Turn right side out. Press, turning in the opening 1/4".



Assembling the Coffee Cozy (continued):

5. Sew a 1/8" stitch to close the opening.



6. Topstitch a 1/4" from the edge, all the way around the cozy.



7. Bring the two short ends together, as you would if it was around a cup, then sew 1/4" from the edge, making sure to backstitch at both the top and the bottom to make sure it is secure. **Important: Make sure the print you want on the outside of the cozy is on the inside when you do this!**



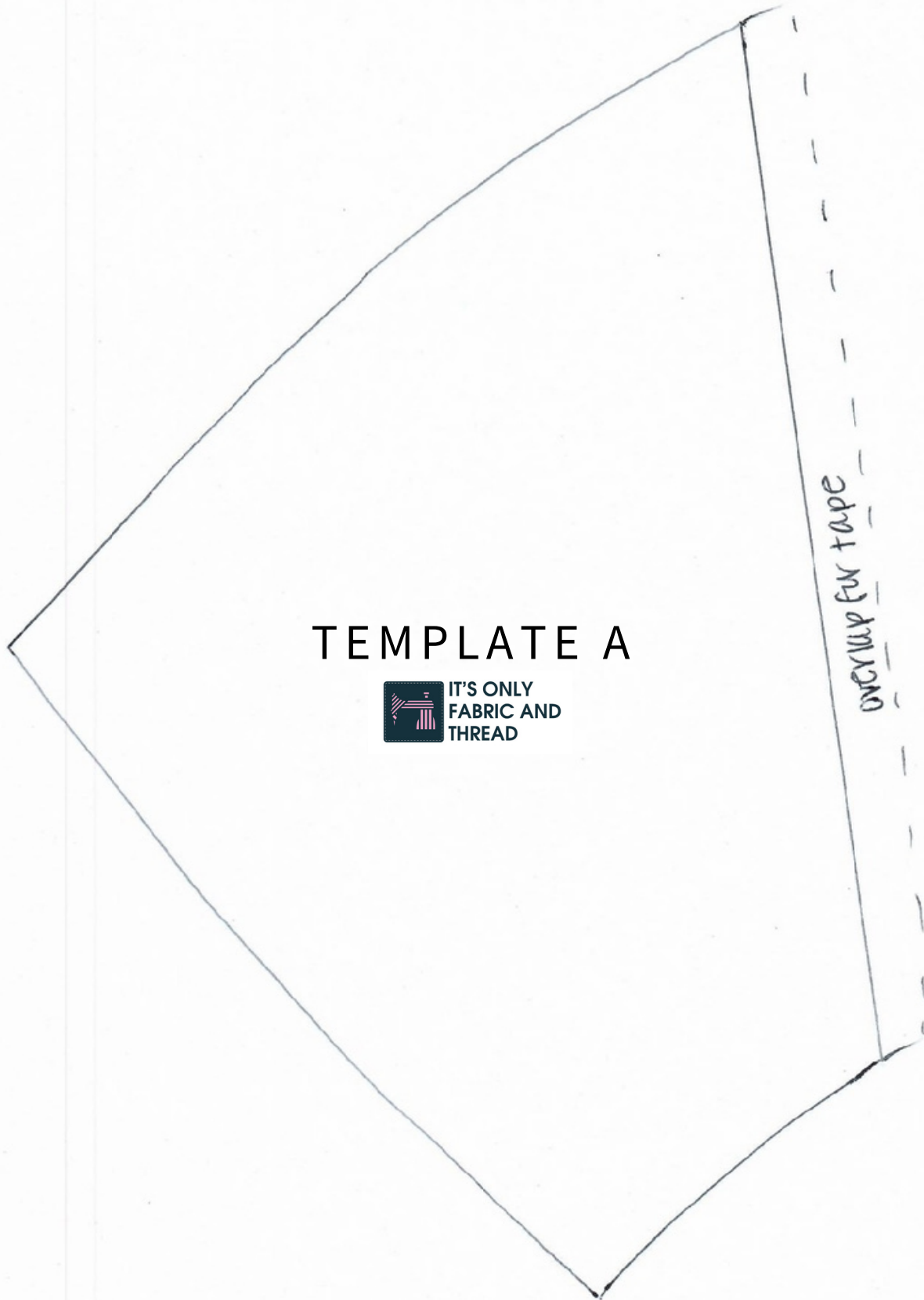
8. Flip right side out and use on your hot beverage!
